RE: Requesting a Public Meeting on Registration No. 185019; Pacifico CCK Energy 1 LLC

Dear Ms. Gharis,

A number of constituents have expressed concerns regarding the application submitted on August 14, 2026, for an electric generating unit standard permit (Registration No. 185019).

Given the level of public interest surrounding this application, I respectfully request that TCEQ hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project. A public meeting would provide an appropriate forum to discuss the facts surrounding the application, address questions directly, and ensure that constituent concerns are heard and considered in a transparent public setting. Given the level of community interest, direct and transparent engagement is particularly important.

I also respectfully request clarification regarding the basis for the project's eligibility for review under the electric generating unit standard permit and the review conducted by TCEQ in making that determination. With the recent withdrawal of the project's local economic development incentive requests, constituents have raised additional questions regarding the project and the regulatory process governing it moving forward.

Providing the public with a clear explanation of the basis for the project's eligibility under the applicable standard permit, including the relevant criteria and review process, would help ensure that constituents have accurate information about the project, the permitting process, and the standards being applied to the application.

In light of the substantial public interest, I respectfully request both that TCEQ schedule a public meeting for Registration No. 185019 and provide clarification regarding the regulatory basis for the application's eligibility under the electric generating unit standard permit.

Thank you for your consideration of this request and for your continued attention to the concerns of the affected community.
